# COMMON QUESTIONS

**Q:** How many students will be in each class?

**A:** We can enroll up to 24 students in each workshop. However, if more than 12 students are enrolled, we will break the group up into two classrooms with two teachers, so there will be no more than 12 in each group.

**Q:** If I enroll my child in two sessions that are 30 minutes apart, is there a charge for you to take care of them during that transition?

**A:** No charge for that! There is a charge for the before and after care and for the lunch group, but the transition block is included when you are enrolled for both sessions.

**Q:** If my child is NOT enrolled in the class before or after, are they allowed to be there during the 30 minute transition block?

**A:** You must wait for the prior class to be completely over and the teacher is available before you may drop off your child because you need to check them in with the teacher and you may not disrupt the prior session. Please do not plan to drop them off before the end of the prior class or expect that they will be checked in right at the end of the prior class. If you aim to arrive no more than 15 minutes before the class begins, and you are in a transition block, you may check in your child and leave. Similarly, please plan to arrive at the end of class to pick up your child. However, if there is a transition block, you may arrive within that block. If you do not pick up your child before the start of the next workshop and they are not enrolled, you will incur additional charges for us to bring your child into the next workshop.

**Q:** Do you have a minimum enrollment to have the class?

**A:** We understand that this often isn't just an enrichment opportunity for your child, but also necessary child care for you while you work or take care of other commitments. If you enroll in the workshop, we will have it even if we have low enrollment.

**Q:** Can we just come M, W, F and pay for 3 days only?

**A:** No. These workshops are five day workshops and are charged for the full week. If your student is absent for some reason they will still be charged, and may not be able to complete all of the planned activities! Please select a week when you know you can come!

## Clay Monsters, Mugs, and More



Students will work to complete 3 clay projects and learn techniques such as coil building, pinch pots and drape pots. The artists will have the opportunity to glaze their pieces to bring home and display!

## A Brush with Nature: A Watercolor Workshop



Begin with a drawing and end with a beautiful watercolor painting!

## Wonderful Weavings



Students will learn basic weaving techniques with mixed media and yarn, and will learn to dye wool yarn. Students will have the opportunity to create an individual tapestry weaving, and will also see examples of how more complex weaving machines function.

## Fantasy Art Creations



Students will get to spend a week in Fantasy Land working with clay and acrylics!

## Fun with Block Printing



Students will learn about the history and processes involved in block printing, and will have the opportunity to use a variety of block printing materials, including linoleum. Students will learn about color separation printing, and create a multi-color print using that technique.

## Plaster Mask-Design, Create, Decorate!



Create your own mask by making a plaster mold of your face! This is an experience you will always remember! Design and decorate your mask. Students will have a mask to take home at the end of the week!

## Creatures on Canvas



Students will be guided through imagining their own creature to design and paint with acrylics!

## Time Travel Steampunk Clay Creations



Students will travel back in time to a week of Steampunk clay creations. Steampunk is a genre of sci-fi art highlighting technology generally of the Victorian era, like clocks, hot air balloons, or steam locomotives. This workshop is a great introduction to sculpting techniques and practice of texture and form.

## Anime/Manga Character Creation



Develop and draw your own unique character! Learn better anatomy drawing skills as you draw your character. Begin your Anime/Manga journey with us!

## Colorful Chameleons



Students will work to complete an acrylic painting on canvas of a chameleon, complete with "puff" texture acrylic.

## Clay Favorite Food Creations



Students will make a complete meal of their favorite foods from clay using handbuilding techniques!

## Pop ARTist Workshop: Icons in Color



This workshop is an exploration of iconic pop art styles and techniques! Students will complete a bold and vibrant pop art portrait of their favorite pop artist (or themselves!) using a color palette inspired by their favorite era or album. The workshop concludes with a creative bonus project: designing funky pop art-inspired friendship bracelets.

## Lighthouse Paintings on Canvas



Students will learn to draw then paint their beautiful lighthouse on canvas using acrylic paint!

## The Artful Axolotl: Painting and Clay



Students will use acrylics to paint their Artful Axolotl on canvas, then sculpt their own Axolotl out of clay!

## Clay Jewelry



Students will make beads and medallions from earthenware clay and polymer clay, and combine with other beads and materials to make necklaces, bracelets, and more!

## Bowling Pin Animal Sculptures



Students will design and create amazing animals sculptures using bowling pins as the body and a variety of materials to decorate the pins.

## Wild About Wicked



Students will experience an Artistic Adventure in Oz, creating their own Emerald Medallion, a canvas painting of the Emerald City, and Sparkly Wand or Wizard's Staff!

## Design and Glaze a Bisque Teapot



Every student will get their own teapot to design and glaze! We will look at examples of tea service designs throughout history and cultures. Students will plan their design and put it on the teapot with food safe glazes.

## Anthropomorphic Portraits in Clay



Students will learn to create an anthropomorphic clay animal figure using clay hand building techniques! Once built, they will glaze their animals.

## Van Gogh's Apprentice Painting on Canvas



Students will learn about Van Gogh, and create their version of the artist's work based on a Van Gogh inspired still life. Paintings will be done on canvas with acrylic paint.
